## Budget / Stewardship Report

We continue to maintain a very good balance. We are in a very good position relative to our “due to” - “due from” with our sister parishes.

The Diocesan Annual Appeal has done very well this year. We have received \$5,951.25 in rebates so far. Looking at that which has been paid in relative to what has been pledged we should expect more before the end of the appeal (June 30).

With Easter coming we should be in excellent position to accomplish some building repairs that have been held off over the past few years.

## Building and Grounds Committee Report

The funds needed are in hand for the replacement of our air conditioners. We are on the list for accomplishing the work sometime this spring.

The closets on the main floor of the church and in the choir loft will be cleaned out, stripped down and renovated with shelving installed. The work will be accomplished this year.

The church bell and ringer control system will be inspected and evaluated by the Verdin Bell Company. When the scope and cost of repair is known this will be reported to the parish.
